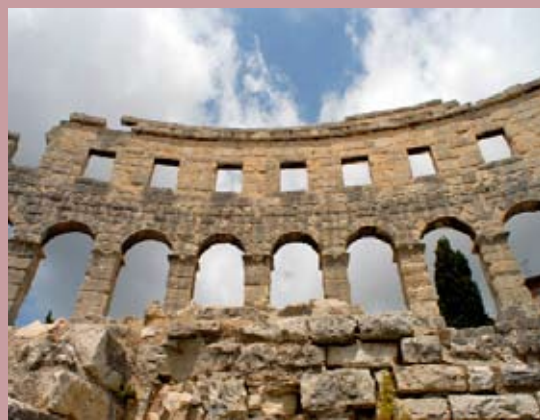

#### **06 July 2011 Depart home cities for Zagreb.**

#### **07 July 2011 arrival Zagreb**

#### **08 July 2011 Zagreb – Lokve (Gorski Kotar) – Turke – Gerovo (Trsce)**

In the morning depart Zagreb and travel to Gorski Kotar and stop at the small town of Lokve, where you can take a relaxing walk in the charming town, along the artificial lake on visit the small underground cave. In the afternoon travel to Turke, north-east of Gerovo. If time allows visit also Tursce on the way to Gerovo. Dinner and overnight at your hotel in Gerovo (B,D)

#### **09 July 2011 Gerovo – Trsat - Opatija**

In the morning travel to Trsat hill-fortress-castle built in 13th century offers a marvelous view of the Kvarner bay. Visit also The Church of Our Lady of Trsat - one of the most important pilgrimage sites in Croatia. According to legend, angels transferred the Nazareth Tabernacle of the Holy Family to Trsat on May 10, 1291. It remained there until December 10, 1294 when, according to legend, angels transferred it to Loreto, Italy. Continue to Opatija. Rest of the day is at leisure. Dinner and overnight at your hotel in Opatija. (B,D)

Start your day with a sightseeing tour of Bled featuring the charming town with the lake-shore, and imposing Bled Castle, perched on a cliff high above the lake. Then take



the typical boat named »pletna« and visit the small island in the middle of the lake. After continue to Bohinj and take the cable car to Mt. Vogel and enjoy light lunch in the Alpine hut and enjoy some relaxing walk before returning to the lake shore. Overnight in Bled (B,L)

### 14 July 2011 Bled – Venice

In the morning travel to Venice. Rest of the day at leisure in Venice (B)

### 15 July 2011 Venice

Today begins with a walking tour of Venice featuring



the major highlights: St. Mark's Square, St. Mark's Basilica, the Doge's Palace, the Bell Tower and the Bridge of Sighs.

### Option #1

#### PULA AND PAZIN – MOSAIC TOUR OF ISTRIA

The road will take you throughout vineyards and olive yards, red plains and green valleys, modest little towns and rich sea resorts. The pearl of our mosaic is Pula and its attraction lays not only in its shop and in factories, but in its ancient past. There is the Roman Amphitheatre, the sixth biggest in all over the world. Pula was even then an important centre. There is also August's Temple, antique City Walls, the Golden Gate and other monuments of the antique past, a local market that is very interesting, and the biggest one in Istria.

The most important centre of Istria mainland is Pazin; an old town with extremely well preserved medieval fortress. It is situated above a 10 meters deep cave and it inspired Jules Verne who described it in one of his novels. Nowadays the Ethnological Museum is placed there and its exhibits tell stories about the life of common Istrian peasant. The last part of our mosaic is a visit to a typical Istrian family. They will offer to the client's home made Istrian wine and cakes, all prepared according to the traditional Istrian receipts. \$65.00

#### ROVINJ – POREČ – MOTOVUN

Rovinj is old fishing town. Venetian, who ruled them for more than 500 years, drew its destiny. It is famous for its narrow streets, small squares and old palaces, built in Venetian style. The baroque church St. Euphemia, the saint protector of the old and fisherman, dominates the town. It keeps a 1500 years old sarcophagus with the relicts of the Saint. From the church terrace, it is possible to admire a miraculous view over The Rovinj Archipelago. Then we will travel on to Poreč, where you will have some free time to enjoy lunch on your own. We will end our day with drive in the heart of Istra peninsula and visit the charming town of Motovun. \$45.00

## FULL PAYMENT IS DUE April 21, 2011

Because motorcoach space is limited, we urge your deposit of \$350 per person as soon as possible. A minimum number of 25 needed to operate the tour.

**2. Baggage Allowance:** The tour operator has requested that there be a limit of 1 large suitcase per person due to space restrictions aboard the motorcoach. NO RESPONSIBILITY IS INCURRED FOR LOSS OF OR DAMAGE TO BAGGAGE OR ANY OF THE PASSENGER'S PERSONAL BELONGINGS. TRAVEL BAGGAGE INSURANCE IS RECOMMENDED AND AVAILABLE THROUGH KOLLANDER TRAVEL. Airline baggage allowance subject to change.

**3. Passport Requirements:** A valid passport is required of all tour participants. A U.S. passport is valid for 10 years. Your passport must be valid for at least 180 days following your return to the United States. To apply for passports you can contact either your local passport office, Clerk of the District, or County Court. Kollander World Travel will be happy to help you obtain the necessary forms.

**4. Tour Price Excludes:** Airline taxes and fees, Airport Departure Taxes, customs user fees, passports, all visa fees, optional tours, telephone, telex, fax and telegram charges, excess baggage charges, sundry tips, laundry, beverages and food not on the regular table d'hôte menu (these items will be billed to you before leaving the hotel, or restaurant), portage at U.S. airports and all other items of a personal nature. Service charges at hotels and restaurants are prepaid. Travel Insurance is not included.

**5. Refund and Unused or Amended Tour Arrangements:** Unused hotel accommodations, tour features or services are non-refundable, nor exchangeable for other accommodations, services or features. Should there be any reason to change features of the tour for the group, any additional expenses will be charged to the tour members. If a change becomes necessary for any reason, hotels substituted will be the equivalent of those shown. Single room available at a supplemental charge.

**6. Cancellation Penalties:** If you cancel your reservation, your right to receive a refund is limited as set forth in the following schedules. All requests for refunds must be sent to us in writing. Charges for cancellation of the tour will be assessed by the participating tour operators, and hotels as follows:
